## **Process**

To build an overview or vision of the website, I first collected inspiration from various websites, pictures, and elements; then it is collated into a mood board. From the mood board, the main theme of 'Traveling in the Tropics' arises since I wanted my website to be inspired by my origin, which is the Philippines, and my experience as a person. Additionally, the mood board also helped me in creating the style guide, which consists of the fonts and colors that are used in the prototype.
